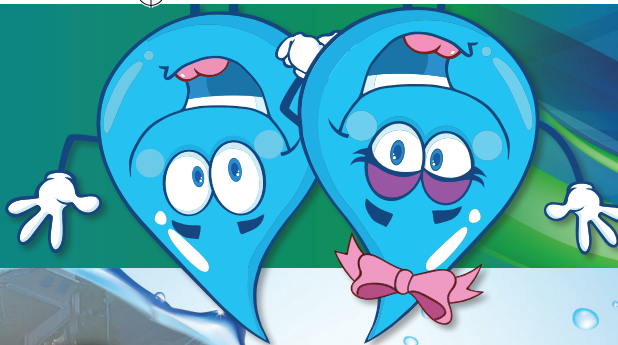

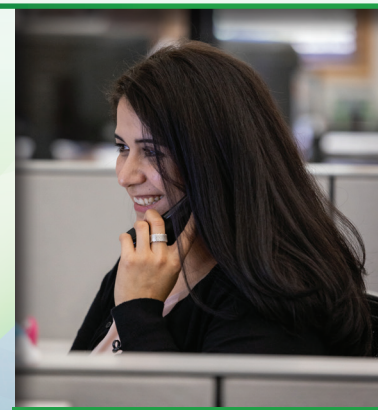
Updates Needed to Customer Accounts

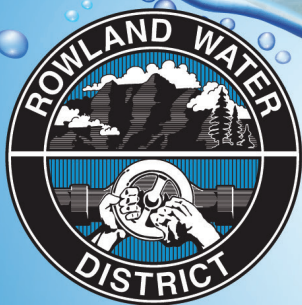

Mini Solar Challenge

Rowland Water District is now offering a NEW program for 4th-6th graders within the District. The Mini Solar Challenge program offers a fun, interactive and hands-on approach while developing mechanical, engineering and mathematical skills.

The Mini Solar Challenge was piloted with the help of 5th Grade teacher La Donna Guzman from Rowland Elementary School. Mrs. Guzman assisted Education Program Coordinator Brittnie Van De Car with the implementation and development of the program's curriculum, guidelines and overall learning curves for the students.

"This program pushes the students to think outside the box and truly tested their STEM skills," said Guzman, Rowland Elementary School. "We are so thankful that Rowland Water District worked with us to create such an amazing program for our kids."

The program is set to rollout during the 2019-2020 school year to 4th-6th grade classrooms within the District.

Solar Cup 2019



Nogales High School competed in the 17th Annual Solar Cup boat race sponsored by Metropolitan Water District and Rowland Water District on May 17-19 at Lake Skinner in Temecula, CA.

The Solar Cup race is a 6-month long program where students build, design and engineer a boat to race solely powered by the sun. Students race in both a 200-meter sprint race and a 90 minute endurance race.

Prior to the races, the team has to submit several technical reports about the mechanisms of the boat and a Public Service Announcement (PSA) about water conservation. Nogales High School had top scores in both the technical reports and the PSA.

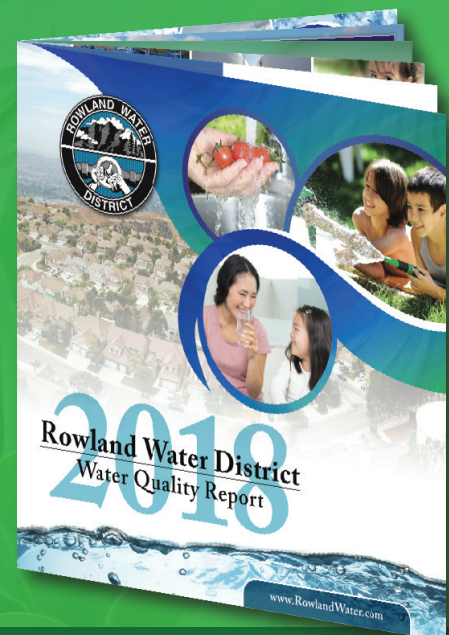

Conservation Patch Program

As part of its extensive commitment to education, Rowland Water District has launched an innovative Water Conservation Patch Program for area Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts. The program was created to serve as a fun, educational adventure culminating with the signing of a water conservation pledge, after which each Scout receives a patch to be worn on a sash or on the back of the child's Scout vest.

Scouts will need to complete a series of water conservation tasks aligned with their age/grade level. For Boy Scouts, the requirements are divided between the Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts levels. For Girl Scouts, the requirements are divided between Daisies, Brownies, Juniors, Cadettes, and Senior Girl Scout levels. The program can be completed individually or as a troop.
